This new plant with integrated continuous furnace was built this year. The company uses it to produce its own brand of CONFORM[®] Med. air cushions. The new plant will enable Wolff Kunststoffe GmbH to expand its production capacity to meet the increased demand. The investment underlines the company's commitment to continuing to produce in Germany in the future and to strengthening the regional economy.

The modern overhead monorail dip-coating system makes work easier for employees, because the previously physically demanding work processes are now a thing of the past. The overhead monorail dip-coating system is highly automated and offers a high level of process control. These features ensure consistent product quality, and energy consumption is reduced by the new continuous furnace.

CONFORM[®] Med. air cushion systems have been manufactured since 1994. The company produces these cushions from natural latex, a natural, renewable raw material. Wolff's production technique is unique worldwide.

The products are medical seat cushions or bed overlays for people who are permanently seated (e.g. paraplegia, stroke, amputation) or whose mobility is severely restricted. The pressure-relieving effect of the cushion helps to prevent pressure ulcers (decubitus prophylaxis) in the buttock area and can also be used to provide therapeutic support for existing pressure ulcers.

In Germany, the cushions are sold through medical supply stores and rehabilitation retailers. They are also used in numerous hospitals. The product, which is 'Made in Germany', is very popular internationally. It is exported to almost all European countries, but also to Canada, Chile, Taiwan, South Korea and the United Arab Emirates.
